Steeped in history, Lanzerac Wine Estate, in the heart of Stellenbosch, is a testament to South Africa's rich winemaking heritage. With roots dating back to 1692, the historic estate has been crafting exceptional wines for centuries.

Known for its pioneering spirit, Lanzerac played a pivotal role in the birth of South Africa's most iconic red grape variety. In 1959, the estate released the world's first bottled Pinotage, a bold and complex wine that continues to captivate palates today. The Pionier Pinotage is a tribute to this very wine.

The estate's vineyards, situated in the prime wine-growing regions of Stellenbosch, benefit from ideal growing conditions, producing grapes of exceptional quality. The winemakers at Lanzerac skillfully harness the unique terroir of each vineyard to create wines that reflect their individual character.

The Mrs English Chardonnay is a tribute to Elizabeth English who renamed the estate Lanzerac in 1920. and the Lanzerac Pinotage, is a powerful and full-bodied red, a tribute to the world's first bottled Pinotage.

The estate's also boasts a five-star hotel, nestled amidst stunning vineyards and majestic mountains.
